About the Project:

Innovation Centre for Eco-Prudent Wastewater Solutions (IC-ECOWS) is a consortium of eminent institutes including National Institute of Hydrology - Roorkee, Indian Institute of Technology- Bombay, National Institute of Technology – Jaipur, and Institute of Rural Management Anand – Anand. IC-ECOWS is funded by Department of Science and Technology, Government of India for a period of five years. The objective is to establish a state-of-art Centre to harness the potential Natural Treatment Systems (NTS) and other eco-prudent resource recovery technologies for water security and sustainability in India. Institute of Rural Management Anand is mandated to conduct the following activities in coordination with the other partner institutes:

- Cost and benefit estimation of identified Natural Treatment Systems (NTS) technologies and development of business model for a variety of Technology Packages of NTS
- Exploration of innovative ideas on the development and application of NTS for wastewater treatment

Job description:

Junior Research Fellow (JRF) would conduct details literature survey on cost, benefit and business models pertaining to treatment systems throughout the world as well as conduct field surveys on cost, benefit and business models of NTS technologies in India. JRF is also expected to manage coordination activities in the project.
